

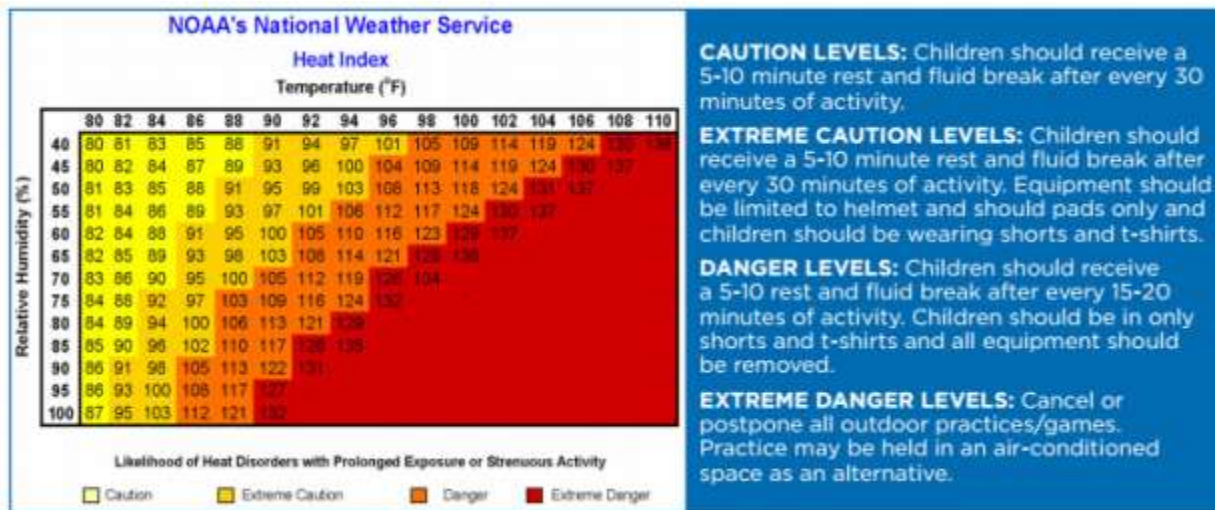


## Myerstown Soccer Club Weather/Heat Policy Updated – August 2021

This weather policy is to help provide a basis for understanding the decisions made to close the fields due to inclement weather and extreme heat. It is meant to help improve the overall experience and safety for our children.

- Soccer will be played during rain unless the fields are deemed unplayable and closed.
  - The fields may only be closed by MSC President or the MSC Facilities Director. If this is during a league game the field may be deemed unplayable by the referee.
- If you see lightning or hear thunder, activities should be immediately suspended, and everyone should go inside a sturdy building or car. Sturdy buildings are the safest place to be. Avoid sheds, picnic shelters, and bleachers. If no sturdy building is nearby, a hard-top vehicle with windows closed will offer some protection.
- Outdoor activity may resume 30 minutes after the last flash of lightning or sound of thunder.
